

Pageant Procedure – BEAUTIFUL BABY

A photographer will be available before and after pageant (Parent's option).

“ONLY ONE” parent/guardian may accompany contestant backstage.

Parent/guardian should help contestant understand the following procedure:

- Contestant will be called backstage by age category, during preceding age category.
- Contestant will participate by numerical order.
- Contestant should practice walking and turning. Only one Parent may accompany children thru age 3 to center stage.
- Contestants will be brought out on the center stage as a group. They will then exit to the side stage and re-enter to the center stage individually when name is called, to talk to the M.C., turn around and exit to side stage. After the entire group has been interviewed individually they will then re-enter to center stage as a group for the final awards.
- Contestant may be interviewed by the Master of Ceremonies. Questions relate to favorite saying, activity and/or hobbies.
- All age categories will be awarded: King/Queen, 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Runners-up or Honorable Mention trophies. Each contestant will also receive ribbons and gifts.
- The parent/guardian will be responsible for their child while he/she is backstage.
- The entry form information needs to be answered correctly to ensure that the pageant runs smoothly and your child is placed in the proper age category.
